REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Anyone may register for the Safety Classes (Forklift, Crane Refresher, CPR/ First Aid, etc.) at any time up to 2 weeks prior to class date *providing there are seats available, Minimum class size is required and if not met, classes may be canceled and / or rescheduled.*

Journeymen wishing to register for Training Classes must do so by calling the Eugene Training Center at either our Eugene number (541-741-7292) or our Portland number (503- 723-6903) *beginning on Monday November 2, 2009.*

In the event any particular class is full at the time of your call, we will maintain a back-up list. You may sign up for a total of two (2) backup classes as available. Should we then have a vacancy develop in a class, we will call you to see if you are interested in attending at that time.

Signing up for an equipment session does not mean that you will obtain a TSP on a piece of equipment. Primary journeyman training seats are reserved for those who do not hold a TSP.

Individuals who are unable to attend their scheduled class must notify the Training Center no less than 2 weeks prior to the class date. This allows us to notify journeymen on the backup list giving them time to plan for their attendance.

The Operating Engineers Training Center is a drug free establishment. **There will be substance abuse testing for everyone registering for journey upgrade training.**

SAFETY TRAINING CLASSES

C-STOP 8hr and 4hr Refresher

HazMat & HazMat Refresher

The HazMat basic class is 40 hours in length. Completing this class successfully gets you your HazMat Card and complies with the OSHA HAZWOPER requirements. It has to be renewed each year to remain in effect. The HazMat Refresher is eight hours in length and permits individuals currently holding a HazMat Card to renew it for one year. All individuals whose HazMat Card expired in 2009 or will expire should attend.

CDL Written Test Preparation

CRANE SAFETY CARD CLASSES

Four Hour Refresher Class: Those successfully completing the course will receive a new 3-year crane safety card with the appropriate endorsements.

Four Hour Tower and Whirley Endorsement Class: Those successfully completing the course will have endorsement code 3 added to their Crane Safety Card. Attendance in this class requires having a current crane safety card and documented practical experience in a tower crane as required by OR-OSHA 1926.550(5)(b).

Two Hour Tower and Whirley Refresher Endorsement Class: Those successfully completing the course will have endorsement 3 renewed on their crane safety card.

NOTE: You may not receive notice that your Crane Safety Card is due to expire. Crane Safety Cards are good for three years. It is the individual operator's responsibility to know when their card is due to expire and schedule their attendance at the appropriate class.

NCCCO Written and Practical tests will be offered pending participation and industry need. Forklift Safety Card Core Class

This three-day course is for those operators who have not yet obtained their OSHA required Forklift Safety Card. All the FL classes will be held at the Eugene Training Center and will begin at 7:30 am and continue to 4:00pm. In order to receive the Forklift Safety Card, participants must demonstrate that they have met the requirements of the OR-OSHA rules. Scheduled classes may be canceled due to lack of participation.

JOURNEY UPGRADE TRAINING

EQUIPMENT

(All classes are held at the Eugene Training Center and run from 7:30am to 3:30pm)

Individuals who are unable to attend their scheduled class must notify the Training Center no less than 2 weeks prior to the class date. This allows us to notify journeymen on the backup list giving them time to plan for their attendance.

All equipment operators are expected to have a working knowledge of grade including the reading of grade stakes. All individuals registering for equipment training will be tested for these skills during equipment training. If you are uncomfortable or unsure of your knowledge you are encouraged to sign up and complete the 40 hr Grade checking class.

Journeymen may only sign up for one equipment category and place their name on the back-up list for two other categories. *Signing up for an equipment session does not mean that you will be placed on any other equipment other than the category for which you registered.*

Backhoe, Excavator, Loader, Dozer & Motorgrader

These individual equipment classes are intended for both operators who have little or no experience (80 Hour / 2 week classes) and experienced operators who wish to brush up on their skills (40 Hour / 1 week classes).
